

CAMP TRIPLE THREAT

February 16th to February 20th 2026

At Camp Triple Threat we present a great challenge to our campers – we have 5 days to create a whole performance from the ground up! Campers will learn vocal technique, music reading skills, choreography, acting techniques, and aspects of show production... all while having FUN! We welcome all children between the ages of 6 and 14 – no experience necessary!

Location: Camp Triple Threat will be held in the performance space at the Smith Mills Congregational Church – 11 Anderson Way Dartmouth, MA. (Rt. 6 Across from Burger King behind the Fire Station).

Hours: Camp takes place February 16th - February 20th, Monday through Friday. It is encouraged that campers be in attendance for all five days of camp to participate. Camp begins at 9:00 am each morning and concludes at 3:00 pm each afternoon, Monday – Friday. Campers may be dropped off between 8:45 AM and 9:00 AM. Campers must be picked up by 3:15 PM.

Our showcase performance will be Friday, February 20th at 2:30 pm.

Drop-off/Pick-Up Policies: Campers will be checked in at the front entrance to the camp and be escorted in. Check-in will occur indoors, allowing us to meet new faces and ensure that all forms and payments are received by staff. On subsequent days, parents may drop off their camper to staff at the front entrance. We ask that all campers arrive by 9:10 each day (we don't want anyone to miss out on important choreography!)

Please let us know if your child will be carpooling or picked up by a different family member/friend, so we may ensure all campers arrive and dismiss safely.

Meals/Snacks:

We ask each camper to bring their own packed lunch each day. We are very active at camp and it is super important your camper's body is fueled. The exception to this request is Friday, February 20th – when we will have our pizza party. Of course, if your camper has dietary restrictions or is just not a fan of pizza they are more than welcome to bring their lunch again on Friday 2/20.

Please ensure that your child has an adequate amount of water each day – we will work up a sweat! It is recommended that a camper bring at least two water bottles, all that singing and dancing will work up a big thirst. Camp Triple Threat provides one snack each day (PM). Your child is welcome to pack their own snacks as well.

Camp Showcase: Our camp showcase will be on Friday, February 20th at 2:30pm. At the end of our week-long program, we invite you all to attend our showcase and see all the hard work your camper

has put into their show! Every camper is given 4 tickets for family and friends to attend the show. As much as we would like to invite everyone in, space is limited with no standing room, in adherence with our fire code.

Reserved seats are assigned based on the timing of receipt of camp applications and deposits. In other words, campers who send in their applications as early as possible will more than likely have seats for the performance closer to the first row!

We try our best to accommodate all attendees, if there is anything important you think we should know, please do not hesitate to contact us, and we will do our absolute best to accommodate all needs.

Payment

<u>Tuition for Camp Triple Threat is \$300.00 per child.</u> Tuition includes Performance score, audio tracks, Performance T-shirt, 4 tickets to our Camp Showcase (Friday, February 20th at 2:30 pm), A snack each day, Pizza Friday,, and more fun surprises! Tuition is broken down into an initial deposit and the remaining balance: due on February 16, 2026.

Initial deposits (\$100) are due upon receipt of camp forms to reserve your camper's spot and are <u>non refundable</u>. The <u>non-refundable</u> deposit reserves placement in the camp and is applied towards important initial costs, camp fees, and rental fees.

The remaining tuition balances (\$200) are due upon check-in on the first day of camp, February 16th, 2026. Any camper without tuition paid in full upon arrival on the first day will not be permitted into the camp.

Refunds

Once paid, all deposits and tuition balances are non-refundable and non-transferable. In addition, no refunds will be given for campers arriving late, leaving early, absences, or any other circumstance that would cause a camper to be unable to attend all or part of a session.

All payments to Camp Triple Threat, LLC may be paid by cash or check, (no Venmo or Cash app, etc). Any checks should be payable to Camp Triple Threat, LLC.
